NEIGHNEIGH away well and raced to the lead from along the rail entering the stretch the first time, held a clear advantage into the second turn, increased her margin in the run down the backside, and was never threatened while finishing four wide in the drive to prove much the best. MISS THE HYPE settled well off the early pace while saving ground at the rail entering the lane the first time, began to improve her position in the run to the final turn, rallied two wide into the turn, and closed three wide in the drive to prove second best. MATSQUI unhurried early while dropping back to trail, launched her bid from along the inside entering the final turn, and finished with late interest two wide in the drive to get up for a share. NU BLEND broke sharply and tracked the pacesetter into the stretch the first time while racing one out from the rail, held her position while losing ground to the pacesetter in the run to the final turn, rallied from along the inside entering the final turn, but was outfinished over the final furlong. CERTIFIABLE away alertly and stalked the leader into the stretch the first time while racing three wide, continued with a wide trip around the second turn, dropped back to trail in the run down the backside, and had nothing to offer in the late stages.
