SO LIKE SILK stalked the pace in the four path, rallied in early stretch and was in time under steady handling. SOMNAMBULIST vied outside, was clear by the half-mile pole and was caught late. BOURBON AND SPICE stalked the pace between rivals and offered a mild late bid inside. SANTIANA stalked the pace in the three path and had no late bid. MORE POETIC WORDS reared at the start, was steadied early and pressed the pace in the two path. PRESUMPTUOUS vied in the three path and gave way near the quarter pole. MY GLENDA FAYE was through early. RONILLA vied in the four path and was steadied near the half-mile pole. MOON LITE GIRL through early. CANDY MIRAGE vied inside and was checked hard near the seven-sixteenths pole. R BEE GEE and. ALEXAS HOPE were bumped at the start.
