SWISS MERINGUE vied between rivals, dueled in the stretch and lasted while kept to task. SWEET SUMMERTIME was off awkwardly, stalked the pace in the four path, dueled late and was outfinished. DREAMING BONITA was bumped at the start, pressed the pace between foes but was no match late. MOON LITE GIRL broke out and was squeezed back at the start, trailed inside, bid in early stretch and faltered. DELCAP ALICE stalked the pace outside, moved to the five path in the stretch and offered a mild late bid. CATTY JUSTICE vied inside and faded near the quarter pole. BEST HAT was bumped and squeezed back at the start and saved ground to no avail. GO EVE GO was herded out at the start, raced well back and was eased. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
