Supplementary nominations may be made by the usual time of closing of entries for a fee of \$625 which includes entry and starting fees. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last the remainder of the purse will be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 125 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2026 allowed, 2 lbs.; of \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2026 allowed, 4 lbs. [Maiden, claiming, starter and state bred races will not be considered when estimating allowances.] Trophy to the winning owner. Management reserves the right to cancel this stake with less than six betting interests. Closed on Saturday, June 27, 2026, with 32 Nominations; 3 Supplemental Nominations.

BENDOOG saved ground, bid inside on the far turn, advanced inside the leader, escaped a savaging by that one and drew off, while taken in hand late. GOULD'S GOLD trailed, moved four wide at the quarter pole and rallied near the eighth pole to claim the place. FIRST DIVISION pressed the pace inside, dueled near the five-eighths pole, bid near the three-eighths pole to be clear, tried to savage the winner as that one flew past and lost focus. INSTANT REPLAY vied between rivals early, settled near the three-quarters pole and lacked a late bid. WOODCOURT vied in the three path early, dueled, gave way near the three-eighths pole and faded in the stretch.
