BUCCHEROS SONG dueled inside, was steadied near the nine-sixteenths pole in tight quarters, saved ground, bid in early stretch and was clear late under a steady drive. CAPTAIN SHAGAF led between rivals and yielded late. CASH PER TRIP was squeezed back at the start, raced in the four path, rallied near the three-eighths pole and couldn't close late. TRICKED YOU raced in the five path and bid belatedly. MY PAL PATRON was bumped at the start, stalked the pace between rivals and faded in the stretch. CHANNELURAMBITION bore in at the start, pressed the early pace between rivals, was steadied slightly near the half-mile pole and gave way in the stretch. J'S JERSEY BOY showed brief speed, faded on the turn and had no late bid. MR. STRIKE was not a factor.
