FOGONERO stalked the pace in the three path, moved to the rail near the quarter pole, bid in the stretch and prevailed under a steady drive. SPEIGHT KNIGHT saved ground, bid between rivals near the three-eighths pole, then couldn't hold off the winner. RED SO O LO was climbing in the early going, raced well back early, bid inside near the half-mile pole, raced in the five path in the stretch and rallied. UNRESPONSIVE was clear early, was caught and gave way near the sixteenth pole. PRO FEVER stalked the pace inside, bid in the three path near the three-eighths pole and faded in the stretch. BASIL was off awkwardly, was unrushed early, raced in the five path and faded in the stretch. MY FRIEND WILSON stalked the pace in the four path and gave way near the three-eighths pole. JOHNNY RINGO was through early. DADE COUNTY stalked the pace in the five path before giving way near the three-eighths pole.
