NO JOKING MATTER vied between rivals, was clear at the eighth pole and lasted under a steady drive. CATATONIC stalked the pace in the three path, bid late and gained the place late. HONEY RED pressed the early pace inside, settled, stalked the pace in the two path and rallied late. LITTLERANSOMSFIRE bore out at the start, stalked the pace in the three path and surged late. G FORCE JIMMI was bumped at the start, stalked the pace in the four path, bid at the quarter pole and rallied late. LUNA LLENA raced in the four path and bid late outside. LIZ'S LEGACY trailed and lacked a closing bid. COLOR ME FAST was off awkwardly and vied inside until giving way near the eighth pole.
