NIGHT KISS stalked the pace in the three path, rallied at the quarter pole, drew off and was ridden out for the win. BEACH KITTEN pressed the pace in the three path, bid at the eighth pole but was no match for the winner. UNBRIDLED DEVINE pressed the pace outside of the leader before giving way near the sixteenth pole. CACTUS FLOWER led inside before giving way approaching the sixteenth pole. CANDY ARCADE stalked the pace in the four path and faded on the turn. CLOSER TOTHE TRUTH saved ground and faded in the stretch. TRES FRANCAIS stalked the pace between rivals before fading near the quarter pole.
