BOITANO stalked the pace in the two path, bid at the three-eighths pole in the three path, was clear in the stretch and held sway under steady handling. FACE VALUE was squeezed back at the start, was unrushed, stalked the pace in the three path and bid late to be second best. EVERDOIT raced well back, bid five wide at the quarter pole but couldn't close late. HYDRO FROST was brushed at the start, dueled inside, lost the path near the quarter pole and gave way. FIREWATER JAKE settled early, saved ground, bid between foes near the three-eighths pole and faltered. HOLD YOUR APPLAUSE faded. KING FALIERO dueled outside before giving way near the three-eighths pole.
