Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

JACK RABBIT saved ground, bid in the three path near the half-mile pole and surged late under steady handling. OLD TRACE was bumped at the start, was unrushed inside, bid between rivals near the quarter pole and rallied late in the five path. PHENOMENAL DREAM saved ground, rallied between rivals in early stretch and couldn't close late. TIMBOS TANGLER pressed the pace in the two path and yielded in the stretch. BRIARCLIFF led inside and yielded in the stretch. BANIDOSO stalked the pace in the three path, bid at the three-eighths pole and faded in the stretch. SOLEVO was off awkwardly and was bumped at the start, stalked the early pace between rivals, saved ground on the far turn and gave way in the stretch. PENEI was unrushed, bid in the six path near the three-eighths pole and faltered in the stretch. FINAL SCENE stalked the pace in the five path and faded in the stretch. GOLD GUNNER saved ground and faded early.
