REIMAGINE raced in the four path, shifted to the seven path near the eighth pole and rallied under a mild drive. FAWN LIEBOWITZ saved ground, rallied at the quarter pole but couldn't close late. CHEYENNE MOON raced in the three path, drifted to the six path near the eighth pole and had no late bid. CROWNED WITH GRACE was off awkwardly, raced well back, bid inside at the three-eighths pole and improved late in the four path. MORGAN'S BLUFF saved ground, bid in the four path near the quarter pole, was steadied near the eighth pole and couldn't close late. AIR FORCE THUNDER was clear early and gave way in the stretch. CHOATE and SMALL TOWN HEROINE were not factors. WEDDING MARCH chased the early pace, gave way near the three-eighths pole and was eased.
