MORE THAN FIVE raced in the four path, bid on the turn, vied briefly in the stretch while three wide and was clear under a steady drive. LORD MAJESTY dueled inside but couldn't hold off the winner. YOLO SANTIAGO stalked the pace in the three path, bid at the half-mile pole, dueled outside of a rival and yielded near the eighth pole. M B'S MUNNING saved ground, angled to the three path on the turn and faded. CABALLO FELIZ raced in the three path and faded. SURFIN SAM saved ground to no avail. HIGH PROBABILITY dueled outside of a rival and gave way on the turn.
