## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

POEMA was unrushed early, bid in the two path near the three-eighths pole, angled to the five path in the stretch, rallied and was clear late under steady handling. SUPER STORMY was unrushed early, rallied in the four path near the three-eighths pole, vied late but couldn't hold off the winner. ELLE EST FORTE bid in the three path near the three-eighths pole and vied late. STORM BAY saved ground, bid in the two path near the half-mile pole and vied late. TIMELESS ROSE saved ground, bid on the far turn, was taken up near the quarter pole to avoid heels, then had no late bid inside. RUN CAMILA RUN was clear early and couldn't last. SHANGHAI EXPRESS stalked the pace in the three path before giving way near the quarter pole. PLANET CLARE raced in

the three path, fading near the quarter pole. LEISUREWEAR (IRE) stalked the pace inside and gave way near the three-eighths pole.
