SCATTITUDE chased in behind near the rail early on the turn, was ridden along while switching out past the five-sixteenths, split foes about the three-sixteenths and gained readily to take charge about a furlong out, held sway under steady handling. MECHAYA settled mid-division, went two to three wide on the turn, came out a bit in the stretch, rallied between foes in mid-stretch, was gaining but too late. BUNDCHEN got away well, dueled inside, put away the sparring partner but was no match for the top pair, kept on well enough while best of the rest. GRADE A chased from outside, went three to four wide on the turn, came out turning for home, kept on for the minor award. MO PICS PLEASE hopped slightly at the start, lacked early speed, came out eight wide, showed late interest finishing well outside runners. GIVE LIFE shifted in early on the turn racing mid-pack stalking outside a foe two to three deep, came out six to seven wide for the drive, ran on but lacked the needed late kick. BIRKIN GIRL check sharply in the early going dropping back, saved ground on the turn, came out a bit in upper stretch and improved. BUNRATTY MANOR (IRE) chased mostly three to four wide and went evenly. TOASTED ROLL

dueled outside a foe, struggled to keep up a quarter from home, steadily weakened thereafter. R PRETTY KITTY broke a step slowly and in a bit tight early, lacked early speed, was never near enough to threaten. THEATRIX was well-positioned outside the leading pair early, shifted in on the turn, chased from inside, faltered and faded. TEMPERS FLY chased mid-pack near the inside, retreated. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
