DUTY BOUND settled back through the early stages of the race in the two path and advanced through the bottom of the turn before circling out around the field, then dueled ELEGANTE MIZ while drifting inwards and just barely prevailed at the wire. ELEGANTE MIZ chased the pace three wide around the turn then came under a drive before the upper and tipped out a bit before coming up then dueling with DUTY BOUND from the inside but was outbobbed at the wire. CARDIO CAT was position mid-pack and settled into it's own pace on the inside to two path before rallying in the upper four to five wide and had a steady in the deep stretch and gave way settling for the show award. VELVET BERETTA broke out at the start and settled into position on the inside and chased the pace, then angled in the upper stretch and was asked but lacked needed kick in the drive. STORMED OFF had a crowded start and settled into stride off the pace at the very back of the field in the two path, then tipped out off the bend five to six wide and showed some interest while mildly improving in the stretch. BRAVOJULIET was off slow at the break but was void of early speed and settled at the back in the three path then showed some kick in the late stretch and made a small gain. CAFFEINE FIX put in an early bid for pace but elected to stalk the leader from the two path then was bumped out in the upper and faded in the drive. PHANTOM FIRE was forwardly placed early along the inside and stalked the pace while being boxed on the rail, became antsy in hand on the turn and forcibly tipped out in the upper bumping a rival but had no kick left in the stretch. DENIAL was in tight at the break and settled towards the back and hugged the rail most the race but made no rally. CHIQUEADA rushed up between rivals at the break to take command of the early pace about a length ahead then inched to the inside coming up the hill then held on til the upper stretch before tiring out. THERE WAS A RIDER'S

OBJECTION FROM CARDIO CAT LODGED AGAINST THE WINNER DUTY BOUND IN THE DEEP STRETCH, BUT AFTER VIDEO REVIEW NO CHANGES WERE MADE.
