IN THE STARS was allowed to settle, moved up heading into the turn racing solo mid-division and removed from the rail, moved out past the five-sixteenths coming into upper stretch six deep and under urging, swept rapidly to the lead past the quarter pole and clear, drew off while drifting in a bit and was kept to the task. TRICKY KITTY lacked early speed dropping back between foes three wide early on the turn, moved out five wide outside foes at the rear soon after, was under urging from the seven-sixteenths, came into upper stretch eight deep, kept on late to get up for the place. LES IS BEST settled off the pace shifting in, saved ground on the turn, moved up late on that bend, tipped out five wide coming to the top of the stretch, drifted in a bit in the lane, lost place late. TAKE NOTE OF THIS settled toward the rear between foes three wide, advanced mildly on the turn, shifted seven wide out of that bend, ran on but needed more. POVERTY WITH AVIEW was forwardly-positioned tracking inside, saved ground on the turn, tipped out coming into upper stretch, ran on. CHAMPAGNE BRUNCH got away well and went straight to the fore, set the pace, saved ground on the turn, was asked by the five-sixteenths, weakened in the stretch. EL ZAIN stalked from between runners in the second flight two to three wide, weakened. ALONGCOMESAWOMAN stumbled then bumped a rival at the start, was coaxed forward, chased from outside, went three to four wide on the turn, came up empty in the drive. ARCTIC VELOCITY bobbled just slightly at the start, was off the rail through the turn racing at the back, failed to menace. RUNNING GAME pressed the pace in hand racing two to three wide on the turn, gave way. ATHENA'S SECRET was bumped after the start, raced outside at the back four wide into the turn, was not a factor.
