## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

PASSWORD vied for the early lead in the two path, took command passing the three-eighths pole, kicked away passing the quarter, and held firm. IRISH LAW chased while ridden along inside of foes early, came under urging in the three path passing the three-eighths pole, and ran on for place. VERY CONNECTED rated in the four path early, was roused at the top of the long stretch, got herded out to the seven path passing the quarter, and rallied to get up for show. PROPS rated between foes in the three path early, was driven into the stretch, drifted out to the six path passing the quarter, and improved. KHETAM raced in range in the two path early, was roused passing the three-eighths pole, but finished evenly. LEVERAGE bumped with an outer foe at the start, was wellback in the three path, stymied at the top of the lane, angled out to the five path passing the quarter, but made no impact. TIMESTREAM settled in the back of the pack along the inside early but had to steady around the nine-sixteenths pole, was driven from the four path into the lane, but made no closing bid. EVA READY bumped with an inner foe at the start, raced off the pace between foes in the two path before angling to the rail passing the half, got stymied from the rail at the top of the long stretch, but stayed on before weakening in the final furlong. WESTERN WARRIOR stalked in the three path but yielded down the lane. RISK tracked inside, was roused in the two path at the top of the stretch, but weakened. MOUNTAIN HIGH dueled for the lead with the winner in the three path early but gave way. SLIDE AWAY dwelt then veered in at the start, was behind along the inside and never menaced. This
