THAT'S FIRE forwardly placed while three wide early, roused four wide to upper stretch, confronted SUN GATE into the lane, dueled that foe to deep stretch and determinedly won the nod. SUN GATE sent for the early lead, set the pace from the inside into the turn, dug in to upper stretch, met the bid of THAT'S FIRE into the final furlong, dueled to deep stretch and just missed for the win, while holding for second. INNOCENT NO MORE settled outside, moved up between foes along the turn, angled in to upper stretch, came within range into the final furlong then angled out and made a sustained rally to the final sixteenth, couldn't reel in the top pair late and was well clear for third. BANDOLIM well placed early on while just off of the pace, roused three wide then caught in tight nearing the top of the stretch, ran in pursuit into the stretch but couldn't muster the needed response late. ROMO crowded at the start and off slow to begin, settled inside, angled widest for the stretch drive, finished evenly. DITLIHI veered in at the start, settled off of the early pace, asked five wide to upper stretch, couldn't sustain a bid to the final furlong and flattened out. GREATEST NATE crowded and bumped at the start, settled mid-pack, saved ground to upper stretch, lacked a response nearing the quarter pole and weakened in the drive. GEORGE OF WILL prominent early, attended to the pace two wide into the turn, vied between foes into upper stretch, couldn't keep pace into the final furlong and gave way. ASHER DASHER crowded and steadied soon after the start, settled outside of rivals to the turn, trailed to the half-mile marker, did not factor in the stretch. CAPTAIN CALL squeezed at the start, settled to the turn, outrun nearing the top of the stretch, was eased through the lane and walked off.
