LITTLE JAMIE forwardly placed early on, tracked the moderate pace three wide to the half-mile marker, roused to upper stretch then vied for the lead at the quarter pole, took command into the lane then dug in for the final furlong, held the runner-up at bay into the final sixteenth and proved best in the late stages. GOOD LONG CRY rated just off of the early pace, was well placed while saving ground to the turn, angled out to upper stretch then rallied to the furlong grounds, was kept at bay late by the determined winner but was a clear second. TIRUPATI ceded the early lead then stalked the pace to the turn, attended to the moderate pace to the half-mile marker, vied for the lead into upper stretch, couldn't keep pace with the leading pair into the final furlong, yielded and just held for third. ONE SWEET GIRL unhurried early on, saved ground into the turn, angled widest to upper stretch, mounted a mild late rally and missed for third. ALTAMIRA SUR squeezed at the start and last away from the gate, raced widest to the half-mile marker, kept a wide trip to upper stretch, couldn't sustain a run to the final furlong and flattened out in the drive. BREEZING ALONG broke in at the start, settled to the turn, coaxed three wide nearing the top of the lane, angled in for the stretch drive, lacked a late response. RESPLENDENCE hard sent to take early command, set the pace from the inside into the turn, carved out moderate fractions approaching the top of the lane, overtaken nearing the quarter marker and faded in the drive.
