## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

REPENTLESS tucked in early, tracked inside in behind the leaders saving ground, came out and split foes past the quarter pole taking the lead, drove clear under urging, held safe. CLARK'S CORNER exchanged a bump then was forced out and in tight at the start, settled into stride, advanced inside a foe off the fence moving out four wide coming past the three-eighths, gained steadily in the stretch but was only second best. CARSON STREET came out after the start, raced up close in pursuit of the pacesetter from outside, went three wide on the turn, lacked the needed late kick. APOLLO'S GLORY broke outwardly, took back and shifted in early, saved ground tracking ahead of mid-pack on the turn, came out past the eighth pole six wide, ran on late. JIRAH broke just a half step slowly, settled inside about mid-pack tracking in behind runners, moved out in upper stretch, steadied on heels when in tight near the sixteenth pole altering inside of a rival, kept on. SILVER SNIPER pursued from outside four to five wide on the turn just off the leader, was asked to keep up past the five-sixteenths, had no late response. VITO CORLEONE bumped with a rival at the start and was shut off, was completely devoid of early speed racing well back of the field, swung six to seven wide into upper stretch and passed tired rivals. MISTER PUNCH was forced out and in tight at the start, chased from mid-pack outside a rival two to three wide, weakened. JET OFF was quick to take the lead, set the pace from off the rail, yielded. ZUCCHERO shifted in chasing from outside a rival two to three wide through the turn and off the leaders, was not a factor. TRABOLTA broke just a half-step slowly, lacked early speed, raced outside a foe carried out from three to five wide near the three-eighths, was never near enough to threaten.
