MASSARAT raced with the second flight, confidently handled through the far turn, raced four wide, waited for racing room near the quarter pole and surged up in his final strides under strong handling. LOVE SONG drafted back to race mid pack early, saved ground through the far turn, shifted out four wide into the upper stretch and just missed in a game effort. MALIBU SMART tracked the top trio early on, raced three to four wide around the far turn, dug in gamely

between rivals and missed. CHA CHA CHUKKA set his own uncontested pace, confronted mid way through the far turn, responded well to open up again and gave way grudgingly in the latter stages. SETTLING STORM under a snug hold early, raced three to five wide in the stretch run and had no final winning bid. HEART SPIN mid pack down the backstretch, had an inside run and needed more in the drive. GOOD GAME trailed early on, raced three wide near the quarter pole, angled out at the three sixteenths pole and had no late rally. STATEMENT MADE raced in hand, ridden through the upper lane, had a two to three wide run and needed more. TARNEEMA raced with the second flight down the backstretch, raced three to four wide into the upper stretch and had no late run. CALL ME TONI raced near the back, was five to six wide into the upper lane from the outside of foes and lacked a solid bid. ALWAYS FOREVER tracked two to three wide and faded. SACRED IMAGE raced six wide near the half mile pole, wide trip and tired.
