BLESS THE BROKEN stalked the pace coming around the hill from the four path and vied between rivals entering the upper and surged when passing into the final furlong before drawing off from the rest within the final sixteenth to prove best. BUTTERCREAM BABE set the early pace and drew clear from the rest briefly leading up the hill then shifted to the two path and kept on digging in down the lane and just held the place award. CLASSIC Q chased the pace early from the inside and tipped out three wide coming up the hill then pressed BUTTERCREAM BABE down to the base of the hill coming four to five wide into the upper but just missed. RASHMI raced in the mid-pack in the five path around the hill and swung out a bit in the upper and vied from the outside but was just short of the money. FAST MARKET settled at the back of the pack in the four path early on and shifted to the two path coming down the hill then tipped to the inside in the upper and vied on the rail but just needed more. VIVE VEUVE saved ground along the inside towards the back of the pack and was well placed coming into the upper but had no kick. PRINCESA MOCHE (PER) raced at the back of the pack five wide to three wide coming around the hill then drifted out in the upper but lacked a rally.
