CREVALLE D'ORO stalked the pace three deep between rivals, confidently handled through the far turn into the lane, ridden near the three sixteenths pole and proved best under strong pressure. SHE'S LOOKIN LUCKY rated back under a hold, raced near the rail in the stretch drive, in tight near the eighth pole and finished gamely to the wire. BELLE OF RIGHTS prompt the early leader two deep from the outside, dug in and kept on willingly to the wire. STRIKINGLY SPUN dropped back to race with the second flight, raced near the inside through the far turn, angled out five wide through the drive and moved up to improve position. SABALENKA settled near the back early on, made a three to two wide bid through the lane and moved up. WINDY WALK stalked the pace from the outside of rivals, raced four to five wide around the far turn and had no final winning bid. WATCH THIS BIRDIE raced mid pack early on, was three to four wide in the lane and had no late run. SUN BEE void of early speed, raced two deep through the far turn, shifted out five wide and

never threatened. CHILLED raced three to four wide around the far turn and had no response. AMERICA'S VOW set a pressured early pace along the inside and faded. IRISH KITTEN raced near the back in the early stages, five wide through the far turn and failed to threaten.
