FUNTASTIC AGAIN brushed a rival at the start and tracked the pace after coming up the hill from the two path then surged nearing the bottom of the upper stretch and took command on the outside of THEISMANN, drawing a length and a half away and held sway until the wire. NAMARON (GER) saved ground along the inside towards the back half of the field for most of the race then found a pocket on the inside rail in the upper and rushed up then tipped out about three wide entering the stretch while being asked and started gaining on the winner in the deep stretch but was just short at the wire. NOISES OFF was

forwardly placed early racing toward the front of the pack then settled back into the mid-pack about three wide off the rail and swung out into the upper into the four or five path while making a bid and briefly held the place award but was outkicked and settled for a clear third best. WESTSIDE TIDE settled towards the back of the pack in the three path and swung out widest in the upper about eight or nine wide and made a late bid from the outside improving well but needed more to contest with the top finishers. NEAT was a step slow at the break and raced off the pace two wide through most of the race then angled out nearing the final furlong marker coming into the seven or eight path and put in a late bid improving in the stretch. WALLEY WORLD settled mid-pack early two wide and tipped out three wide into the upper looking to make a bid but was steadied after coming on the heels of a weakening opponent just after passing the quarter pole and weakened after. SCIPIO raced up close early on out of the gate and shifted back, tracking the pace three wide around the hill before tipping out about four or five wide around a rival in the upper and made a short bid just before the final furlong marker but weakened in the stretch. THEISMANN popped the gate before the race, set a pressured pace after leaving the gate and shifted to the inside and kept on until the three sixteenths marker and was passed up by FUNTASTIC AGAIN then faltered. SPECIAL JUSTICE pressed the pace early on from the three path coming around the hill and kept on while weakening a bit to be a length behind and was placed between rivals heading into the upper before steadying passing the quarter pole and faded shortly after. RAPOPORT was brushed by FUNTASTIC AGAIN at the break and was void of any early speed quickly trailing the field while being along the inside and was no factor.
