SUSPICIONS was bumped by an outer rival and brushed with an inner foe soon after the start, vied for the lead with an inner foe while kept in the three path around the turn, forged command while remaining in hand entering the lane, changed leads once set down at the three sixteenths pole, drove clear then held sway. BOURBON TOWN raced close up to the top pair early on, stalked from the two path around the turn, shifted to the four path into upper stretch, ran on to gain place at the furlong grounds then held that position. TIGRADO shied from an inner foe and brushed with an outer rival at the start, chased in the four path, floated five wide into upper stretch, stayed on mildly while hanging on his left lead, changed over while vying for show with an inner rival at the sixteenth pole and edged that positoin. SUPER SAIYAJIN broke slowly, saved ground off of the pace, stayed on up the rail to vie for show in the final sixteenth but was denied. JOE JOE DUDE came out multiple paths while breaking sharply, set the pace near the inside while vying with the eventual winner into and around the turn, but yielded in upper stretch then faded between horses. CROSS POWER tossed head under a right handed crop, leaned in, bumped a rival and steadied back at the start, trailed near the inside and got outrun.
