ADMIRAL HALL stalked from the three path, ranged up turning for home to bid at the quarter pole then drove clear. BACKSIDE vied for the lead with an outer rival, disposed of that one and led around the far turn, but got headed by an outer bidder at the quarter pole, proved no match yet was clearly second best. DOKKODO vied two wide, faded between horses with five sixteenths to go, yet kept on to vie for show with an inner foe through the final furlong and narrowly prevailed. HIGHLIGHTER bumped an outer foe at the start, stalked along the inside, chased turning for home, lacked a bid before vying for show with an outer rival through the final furlong but got bested. OTZELBERGER leaned out subtly at the start, raced off of the pace in the three to four path and failed to factor. PUNKIN BOY took contact from an inner foe at the start, trailed near the inside and got outrun.
