OUTFIELDER vied three to two wide, dueled with an inner foe around the turn, forged an advantage in upper stretch, inched clear shortly after as an outer OSCAR'S HOPE took aim and held sway under a drive. OSCAR'S HOPE stalked in the three path, claimed place while taking aim outside of the new leader at the three sixteenths pole, then chased well through the final furlong but was kept at bay. SOMETIME transferred contact from an inner rival to an outer foe at the start, trailed in the two path, entered the lane in the four path, fanned out wider into the final furlong and moved up. PAPA KEN chased in the two path into the turn, then between horses leaving the three furlong pole, pursued the leaders while moving out to the four path in midstretch, sustained a chase to offer a late bid for show but got outkicked. IMAGINE JOHN was bumped by an inner foe at the start, raced off of the pace in the three path, crept closer around the turn, flattened out while getting floated to the five path in midstretch and yielded. SWUNG led narrowly two wide and between rivals early on, dueled with only his outer counterpart around the turn, but got headed in upper stretch and weakened. MR. SENSEI leaned into an outer rival at the start, vied for the lead with an outer pair, but gave way into the turn and weakened.
