WHOS THE V broke in/bumped start, edged away. AB SEIS CORONAS solid effort outside. ITS A GOOD VALENTINE steady effort. DR URBAN COWBOY in mix, needed more. CHECKN EAGLE bumped start, shied 1/8. TRIGO wide path, evenly. CARIBBEAN broke in/brushed, bothered early. BEYOND REPAIR antsy, broke in, lacked rally. SIXTEENTH POWER bumped start, lugged in early. FLAMING JESS CANDY leaned out early, equipment malfunction.
