BEAUDREAUX behind the lead pack exiting the chute well out in the strip, moved closer in the four path early in the turn, engaged the leader from the outside late in the bend, long, spirited duel to the wire, edging away late under firm handling. RIPPLE'S ROCKET broke with the leaders, vied on the outside onto the main track, garnered a larger advantage into the turn, responded when the winner came calling with a quarter mile remaining, dueled with that one to the wire, proved stubborn until the final strides. ALAJUELA with the early pace inside, leaned into the gap out of the chute, fell back, saved ground into the turn, moved out around a tiring rival late in the turn when advancing, continued with steady interest to finish best of the rest, no threat to the top pair. AY AY RON with the pace while between foes early, pressured the winner to that one's inside into the turn, began to weaken soon after, continued to fade. TITO broke back, lagged well back, continued to lag well back, four wide through the turn, made little impact in the drive. GEAX WARRIOR flashed some brief early foot inside the runner up, began a steady retreat after a quarter.
