AWESOME NAME stalked the leaders on the outside in the run up the backstretch, four wide into the turn, advanced through the bend and challenged in the three path into the lane, dueled with the runner up through upper stretch then pulled away in the final furlong under steady handling. BOTTLE IT vied up front between horses early, dueled into the turn off the inside, put a head in front late in the bend as the winner was beginning to make his move, put the other speed away soon after, dueled with the victor in upper stretch then could not keep pace. OBVIOUS CONCLUSION off a step slow, moved up steadily the opening furlong to race behind the first flight inside the winner behind the lead pack, dropped to the inside midway on the turn and had little left for the stretch run. PEA EYE broke with the leaders, contested the issue early three wide, fell back off the remaining speed into the turn, gradually weakened in the run to the wire. CAJUN SWAGGER one paced early while well out in the strip, four wide through the turn, lacked a closing kick. CODE OF PARAPLUIE showed good speed along the inside, faltered when headed by the runner up late in the turn. CIEL off a step slow, saved ground to no avail in failing to make an impact.
