HUSTLIN' MAN behind leader early while along the inside, covered up in some traffic through the turn to lose some position, eased out and advanced entering the stretch, bid between foes when straightened for home, wore down the pacesetter under firm handling. ME PROMESA broke running from the outside, showed the way up the backstretch, given a bit of a breather through the turn under light restraint, responded when challenged by the winner from the outside entering the straight, dueled with that one past the furlong marker and proved stubborn to the end. OLE MISTER bobbled just after the start, raced well back off the pace toward the inside, continued to save some ground into the lane, improved to finish up best of the rest, no real threat to the top two. OUR BODIE forwardly placed while racing off the inside, moved a bit closer into the turn, three wide and between horses into the lane, lacked a closing kick. PATEK within striking distance while racing outside in the run up the backstretch, moved moved closer late in the bend, fanned four wide into the lane, came up empty in the run to the wire as well. BAYOULAND RED fell back after the start and failed to menace.

SURELY THE ONE off slowly to spot the field a couple of lengths, raced unhurried for a half, angled out and was four wide into the lane, set down for the drive, rallied, challenged on the outside, challenged with less than a furlong remaining and proved best under firm handling. TROT THIS WAY chased the dueling leaders while in the three path, advanced outside that pair into the lane, gained the advantage, responded and dueled with the winner when that one came calling inside the furlong grounds, gave ground grudgingly to that rival. LOVE ME SOME CANDY dueled up front while off the inside, continued to alternate up front into and through the turn, fell back off the other speed in upper stretch, angled in, came back for the show spot while unable to contain the top two. MY SWEET ANGEL away in good order, dueled up front closest to the inside, shook clear in upper start, drifted out a bit and faltered to lose the show while also proving no match for the top pair in the final sixteenth. B'S LUCK slow to settled out of the chute while falling back, trailed throughout in failing to menace.

TWOKO BAY close up from the start, prompted the leader in the three path through the first turn, continued to stalk that rival up the backstretch and into the far turn, moved to challenge that same foe in the two path turning for home, put a head in front upper stretch and kicked clear under steady handling. SEVEN CHANNELS settled in the second flight while along the inside, continued to save ground the middle half mile, eased out a bit when chasing the two frontrunners nearing midstretch, could do little with the winner, staged a mild rally late to be just up for the second spot. NAPOLEONIC CODE broke alertly, showed the way past the wire the first time, continued to set the pace up the backstretch through some soft fractions, quickened into the far turn, offered brief resistance to the winner when that one challenged late in the final turn, proved no match in the drive, nailed late for the place. PARROT HEAD in mid pack while off the inside and between horses first turn, continued to run with the main body, two path again through the second bend, displayed a mild amount of late interest to better his position in the late going. SIR MACK back off the pace and the inside when three wide early, also remained in midpack through the final turn, lacked a closing punch. DUDE DROP KID off a step slow, raced five wide into the first turn, continued outside and back, four wide into the second bend, came three wide for the drive, also finished up evenly to be found lacking late. SLAVA UKRAINI lacked speed off the inside, raced a bit rank late in the first turn in the two path, remained back, saved ground second bend, lacked a closing response. BIG TAP BABY off a bit slowly, void of speed off the inside, four wide through much of the second turn, failed to muster a rally as well. BANDERA BLING four wide into the first turn when back,

continued to lack speed and was not a factor.
