TENSAS CLEAR broke with the leaders, vied up front in the four path and widest up the backstretch, continued to race four wide through the turn, lost some ground to the leader while was along the inside into the straight, got back to that one from the outside with less than a furlong remaining and wore that same foe down under firm handling. DEMOTION maintained inside position in the lead pack after the start, continued to battle up front into the turn, gained a larger advantage over the winner with a ground saving trip into the lane, gave ground grudgingly to that one late. SARAH'S ROLLING off a step slow, raced back and outside, four wide far turn, moved out a bit further to be five wide into the straight, lodged a willingly rally down the center of the course while too late for the top two. OUR INDIAN GIRL in the second flight while racing three wide, lacked a serious closing kick to finish up evenly. LITTLEBITOFAQUEEN hesitated at the break, trailed as a result, saved ground through the turn, picked off a couple of tiring rivals to improved slightly, no real threat. OSTRICA vied up front while racing three wide up the backstretch and between horses, faltered in the drive. EX GONNA early foot while in the two path between horses, shuffled back early in the turn, continued to fade.

BORONGAN broke sharp from the outside, cleared out of the chute down to the two path, dropped to the rail when showing the way into and through the turn, continued to hold the advantage into the lane, turned back a mild bid from the runner up in midstretch and maintained daylight to the wire under steady handling. ONE GRAND SLAM within striking distance out in the strip, three wide through the turn, crept a bit closer to the winner from the outside approaching the furlong marker, could do little more with that one while clearly second best. BELLASTONE COUNTRY forwardly placed up the backstretch inside, fell back through the turn, cut the corner into the lane to once again reach a striking position past the furlong marker, flattened out, saved the show. MAKE ME A DEAL back off the pace while well out in the strip, four wide through the bend, set down for the drive while widest, went evenly the final furlong in lacking a closing punch. ACESRAISEDTHE BAR lacked speed, encountered some traffic in mid pack with just over a half to run, moved out a bit to race in the three path by midway on the turn, also found lacking when the real running began at the head of the lane. BABBLING BROOKS fell back from between horses early and was never a factor.

REBEL MOON forwardly placed while four wide and between horses into the first turn, angled in a bit when prompting the leader onto and up the backstretch, took over from that one late in the final turn, drew out through the lane while being kept to task. PEYTON'S DAY with the lead pack while five wide into the first turn, worked way toward the inside a bit onto the backstretch, prompted three wide into the far turn, proved no match for the winner, clearly second best. MUCHO MACHO CAM off a step slow, raced back off the pace along the inside, moved up a bit onto the backstretch to head race in the second flight, remained inside through the final bend, finished up best of the rest with some mild interest. CAUSE IM THE KING six wide into the first turn, four path when with the chase pack onto the backstretch, continued in the four path through the second bend, moved a bit closer then went flat through the lane to finish up evenly. I BET YOU WONT rank when five wide into the first turn, continued keen late in that bend, settled in the second flight while between foes the middle half, came up empty for the stretch run. VEGA STAR showed the way into the first turn off the inside, continued to set a pressured pace the middle four furlongs, headed by the winner turning for home, switched out, and continued to weaken. INACLASSOFMYOWN broke out, shuffled back in some traffic midway on the first turn, fell back, saved ground when trailing through the final bend, failed to muster a rally. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

SIP AND GO away well, narrowly showed the way up the backstretch and into the turn, edged away a bit turning into the stretch, set down, just enough left to hold the next two safe at the wire. CONCENTRATION in tight and bothered just after the start, raced back early as a result, steered out three wide early in the turn, began to advance soon after, continued a steady gain and finished up willingly to be in time for the place while widest of the first group at the wire. ARANSAS PASS off a step slow, trailed just off the inside, continued in the two path second turn, failed to menace. BARB'S GIRL off a step slow, raced back while four wide early in the first turn, continued outside, floated out to be four wide again turning into the stretch, lugged in nearing the furlong grounds and remained back. IN SPEIGHT OF ZOOM broke well, showed the way into the first turn in the two path, replaced on the lead by the runner up before a half and began a steady retreat thereafter.
