TRUST DADDY moved up steadily to join the fray from the outside into the turn, continued to force the issue in the three path through the bend, fell back off the leader slight by losing some ground to that one into the lane, long, spirited drive, just up at the wire. PRODIGY PARADISE with the pace early while off the inside, continued to do battle while between horses turn, put a head in front late in the bend, continued to hold the advantage past the furlong marker, dug in late to narrowly miss in a game effort. THAT'S RIGHT in mid pack while along the inside early, steered out to the two path around a tiring rival late in the turn, set down for the drive, finished with energy to be coming late while between the top two. OUR BUCKY CHARM lacked speed off the inside, moved out to be four wide by late in the turn when moving a bit closer, flattened out a bit the final furlong to finish up evenly. BATTALION STRIKE off a step slow, trailed early just off the inside, cut the corner into the lane, lacked a closing response. GABARRA settled in mid pack while racing in the two path, also failed to muster a rally. COUNTRY HIT set the pace four almost three furlongs along the inside, gave way when headed by the runner up late in the turn. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
