C MAC DA BOSS hard to load prior to the start, was away in good order then took command to the first turn, set a moderate pace from the two path into the backstretch, kicked clear nearing the top of the lane, drew off through the stretch and was ridden out late to win as much the best. WEITZMAN well placed while saving ground early on, tracked the pace from the inside heading into the far turn, swung to the two path to upper stretch, was no match late for the winner but bested the rest for the place. NORTH OF BALI allowed to settle while never far back, saved ground into upper stretch, needed more for the stretch drive but outfinished RANDY DAYTONA to earn the show. RANDY DAYTONA fractious prior to the start, was away in good order and forwardly placed to the first turn, tracked the pace two wide and between runners into the backstretch, gave chase into the far turn, lacked the needed response three wide into upper stretch then weakened in the lane. GHOST NATION crowded at the start and last away from the gate, lacked early speed, trailed to the half-mile marker, coaxed from the two path to upper stretch and failed to threaten in the drive. PYROMANIA rated off of the early pace, moved to the outside of rivals into the first turn, stalked the moderate pace three to four wide nearing the half-mile marker, gave chase into the far turn, couldn't find more to upper stretch and gave way.

PATH TO SUCCESS vied for the early lead from the outside then took command to the backstretch, set the pace from the two path heading into the far turn, met the bid of KINGSCOTE nearing the top of the lane, dug in to mid-stretch, drifted under left hand urging in the drive, responded late and held safely. KINGSCOTE crowded a bit at the start then trailed approaching the first turn, moved to the outside of rivals and was five wide nearing the half-mile marker, loomed into the far turn then confronted his stablemate to upper stretch, gamely battled into the lane but was denied for the win. BAG OF GOLD was forwardly placed while outside of rivals, tracked the pace three then four wide nearing the half-mile marker, chased into the far turn, couldn't match strides with the top pair into the stretch drive but stayed on late to be a clear third. RINGSIDE crowded an inner foe leaving the gate, settled and saved ground to the backstretch, chased from the inside into the far turn, kept an inside path to the stretch, couldn't find more in the final furlong and gave way. ROCKALL hard to load prior to the start, settled in the second flight to begin, tracked the pace two to three wide nearing the half-mile marker, lost ground between foes into the far turn and came up empty in the stretch drive. LEAVING SHADOWS broke alertly, vied for the lead to the first turn, took a stalking position into the backstretch run, dropped back into the far turn and tired.

DEACON JONES rated off of the early pace, saved ground to the turn then angled out, set down three wide to upper stretch, rallied from the four to five path in the lane, took command at the sixteenth-marker then edged clear in the late stages. BIG DUCK vied for the early lead then took command, set the pace from off of the rail along the backstretch, dueled outside of BOY CHARLIE into the turn, continued to battle that foe into upper stretch, drifted to the three to four path into the lane, overtaken into the final sixteenth, couldn't match strides late with the winner and held well for second. BOY CHARLIE forward early, went up to press the pace from the inside, disputed the pace to the quarter pole then vied for the lead to upper stretch, continued to battle from the rail into the final furlong, was outkicked in the final sixteenth, missed for second and was a clear third. LIVE AFFAIR took back and settled outside, asked four wide to upper stretch, needed more in the lane and finished evenly. GIRLIE'S MAX close up to the early pace while between runners, stalked the pace to the turn, dropped back along the bend then came up empty in the stretch.
