DOCTOR LEO prompt the early leader from the outside, had command near the five sixteenths pole and widened his lead under steady handling. COUNTRY GUY urged along early, raced three wide through the far turn and kept on to finish second best. SAMURAI'S GRANDSON dropped back to race mid pack, was three wide near the quarter pole and need more for the top pair. EL DEAL ME ACES set a pressured early pace from the inside and faded. SHANKINSTINE dropped back early, saved ground and never threatened. LOUDTHUNDRHEVYRAIN was off very slow, raced three to four wide around the far turn and never threatened.
