ETERNAL LEGACY with the pace from the start off the inside, dueled through the turn in the three path, shook clear when straightened for home, lugged in a bit past the furlong marker then maintained daylight to the wire under firm handling. FOURFORFORTYFOUR forwardly placed while well out in the strip, moved closer four wide through the bend, proved no match for the winner stretch, held sway for the place. STANDARD ISSUE broke forwardly, set a pressured pace into the turn, dueled with the winner through much of that bend, could not keep pace with that rival or the runner up stretch, comfortably saved the show. VELOCITY VIXEN bumped at the start, four wide into the turn when in the second flight, three wide for the stretch, went evenly to the wire. GOD'S PLAN broke out bumping VELOCITY VIXEN, raced well back early just off the inside, swung out four wide exiting the turn, improved position with some mild, belated interest without posing a serious threat. GRAND EAGLE in mid pack off the rail, between horses midway on the turn, lacked a closing kick. NAZARENE a bit green early in falling back to trail, never threatened. JACTANI in the second flight for three furlongs along the inside, backed up through the stretch.
