C D'S WILD FIRE raced near the back down the backstretch then fell to last on the turn and made a mid track rally with his best strides late to draw clear late. LOUISIANA NATIVE stalked the pace from off the rail to the top of the stretch then made a rail bid to match strides inside of A G'S GEM and LEISURELY to the wire and was second best. A G'S GEM sped away from the gate then matched inside of LEISURELY through the turn then matched strides with that one and inside of LOUISIANA NATIVE to the wire and was denied by the late closing outside rival. LEISURELY vied for the early lead from two wide then engaged the leader midway through the turn and matched strides outside of A G'S GEM and LOUISIANA NATIVE down the stretch but was outkicked late. BLONDATE showed no early speed then made a three wide bid and the quarter pole but flattened out. RODESSA FLASH raced in the middle of the pack from off the rail but was never a threat.
