PRINCE JAMES vied for the lead from three wide down the backstretch then moved up to take the lead near the three furlong marker and drew off to prove best. COLONEL BARTON shared the command to the turn was overtaken near the three furlong marker then dropped in and bothered foe midway through the turn but kept on to hold the place. MISTER MONTE CARLO shared the command to the turn then steadied midway through the turn and lost action but made a rebid for the late gain on place. SAMSPLAYERSLOUNGE raced near the back and was never a factor. SHANKINSTINE was always back and passed tiring rival. DALTON'S RUTROW raced close up on the pace from four wide to the top of the stretch then gave way. JOCKEY OF MISTER MONTE CARLO CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST COLONEL BARTON FOR INTERFERENCE ON THE FAR TURN, AFTER A STEWARDS REVIEW CLAIM OF FOUL WAS ALLOWED AND COLONEL BARTON WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND TO THIRD.
