DISPOSITION raced close up behind horses down the backstretch while a bit rank, loomed four-wide turning for home, then flattened out mid-stretch under urging. MISS GYPSY broke slowly then got off to an awkward beginning, lagged at the rear of the field, lacked a rally, and was never a threat. LASKO LADY broke slowly and did not get into stride right away, moved up some on the turn while keeping to the inside, and kept up a steady pace in the late stages to improve. HAVEN'T A RED CENT broke well and was sent to the front, set a pressured pace to the turn, then gave way at the top of the stretch and tired. MEMORY MAKER pressed the early pace between horses, dropped out approaching the quarter pole, was kept to task and came back on in mid-stretch, collared MENTY B on the lead and won going away. MENTY B pressed the early pace three wide, took over the lead past the quarter pole, had a clear advantage in upper stretch, but could not hold off the winner in the late stages. MY LIL POKER FACE broke well then settled mid-pack through the early stages, advanced to contention approaching the quarter pole, bid five-wide into the stretch, then finished up well under steady handling but was outfinished in the final yards.
