SUPPER CLUB was hustled from the break, then veered out across the path of some rivals, made the front, and was left to dictate the fractions with a pair in close pursuit, gave way passing the quarter pole, and stopped in the stretch. BELLA BLU MOON got forced out into a rival shortly after the start, pressed SUPPER CLUB two-wide through the first half, then bid for the lead approaching the quarter pole, was quickly overtaken by the top pair in upper stretch and lacked a late response. DEWEY'S SOLDIER walked away from the gate, spotting the field a bit of a head start, raced well behind the field through the first half-mile, then started to run on after passing the three-furlong pole, was never a threat to the top pair but outfinished the rest of the field to claim the third prize. AMERICAN TAYLOR lost the path early, took up and chased the main pack through the early stages, moved up heading into the far turn, then swung four wide at the top of the stretch, then finished up well under steady handling to collar MISCHIEVOUS CANDY in the final furlong. MISCHIEVOUS CINDY settled in a tracking position not far from the front, made a three-wide bid for the lead at the quarter pole, then drew clear in upper stretch, then was unable to hold off a late bid from the winner in the final yards but finished a mile clear of the next horse. WHATEVERYOUSAY was reluctant to load, veered out at the start, rushed up three wide through the first turn, was forwardly placed to the far turn then faltered.
