MR. FAVERSHAM rated inside entering the backstretch, improved going into the far turn, tipped out to the three path under a drive passing the quarter, then swung from the five path into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, drew past an inner pair before the sixteenth, and went clear. NOPENOTTONIGHT showed the way along the inside turning into the backstretch, was shaken up for more run midway around the far turn, dug in gamely when challenged by Time To Party passing the quarter, got caught by the late charging winner around the sixteenth, but held place. TIME TO PARTY settled up close just behind the pacesetter in the two path, was cued to bid midway around the far turn, ran on to sustain the bid into the final furlong, but evened out late to show. CRITICAL THREAT was off slow and trailed along the inside turning into the backstretch, moved up a spot under a drive passing the quarter, but made no impact. RED ROAD stalked the leading duo from the three path turning into the backstretch, came under pressure heading into the far turn, but retreated.
