BABY KRISTEN broke running from the middle of the course, prompted the leader in the three path up the backstraight and into the turn, dueled then took over late in the bend, shook clear and held a comfortable advantage through the stretch under a steady hand ride to win ridden out. MILLIE'S STARDUST asked early from along the inside to hold forward position, showed the way up the backstretch in the two path, dueled with the winner in the turn then could not keep pace through the stretch, stayed clear for the place. CAJUN CATTITUDE bumped with GOLDEN BARCENTS at the break, raced in the second flight while between horses, chased the dueling leaders into the stretch while in the two path, slowly getting to the runner up late. RUMPUS raced in the second flight inside, fell back a bit with three furlongs to run, continued to save ground into the stretch, went evenly to the wire in lacking a closing kick. GOLDEN BARCENTS bumped at the start, lacked speed while out in the course, raced three wide through the turn, made little impact through the stretch. BEAUTIFUL TEMPLE broke through the gate prior to the start, second group while three wide, tired.
