TANGO MIKE MIKE broke back, raced off the early pace toward the inside, crept closer in the two path late in the final turn, in traffic, moved out for the drive, set down, late surge to be up in time. REBEL MOON in the second flight in the two path through the first turn, continued within striking distance up the backstretch, challenged along the rail inside the pacesetter far turn, dueled into the lane, took over, led late, proved no match for the winner in the late going. BLUE CHAIR BAY broke well, set or forced the pace while racing off the inside, dueled with the runner up into the stretch, yielded to that rival while also proving no match for the winner, saved the show. MIDNIGHT HALO within striking distance while four wide into the first turn, three path onto the backstretch, asked along through the final bend, floated out four wide by the winner tur4ning for home, not enough late for the show. PEYTON'S DAY vied early along the inside, fell back and tracked the pace while saving ground the middle half mile, had little for the stretch drive. PYROMANIA trailed early while off the inside, continued out in the course to be four wide through the second turn, had nothing for the drive to trail in.
