BLESSED ANGEL was closest in pursuit in the early going, chased outside OVETA'S HOBBY on the turn, bid between at the quarter pole, put a head in front midstretch, dueled with OVETA'S HOBBY through the final furlong and won bob on the line. OVETA'S HOBBY chased from off the pace to the turn, gained along the fence around the bend, challenged at the top of the lane, dueled with BLESSES ANGEL in the last furlong, dug in gamely but got outnodded at the wire. MY KAT hustled early, chased three wide leaving the backstretch, spun five wide into the lane and got up for third. ELTONSINGSANOTHER chased from off the pace, went three, four, then five wide around the bend, offered a mild response in the lane but got edged for the show honors. TIZ THE PROSPECT sprinted clear and crossed over, drifted four wide around the bend, met bids from a pair of rivals at the top of the lane, fought to midstretch and weakened. PRINCESS DADDY raced off the pace in the early going while well off the rail, exited the backstretch in the four path, eased out further and came seven wide into the lane and failed to rally. NEEZER DALTON stumbled slightly to lose a step at the start, trailed two wide into the turn, went three wide into the lane and had little left for the final furlong.

YOU TRUST ME broke in, chased the top trio then drew alongside four deep, pursued the leader in the four path on the turn, challenged from outside in the lane, took over in the last sixteenth and was in hand near the wire. SMOKEM JEANNINE vied three deep to the turn, could not keep up with the leader early on the bend, chased in the three path to the stretch, drifted inward midstretch, dug in gamely in the last sixteenth but was outkicked by the winner. PRINCESS LUNA vied inside rivals up the backstretch, moved clear early on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch, showed the way into the final furlong, relinquished the lead at the sixteenth pole and yielded to the top pair. SHEMAKESMEMAD broke inward, fought for the lead between rivals, chased after the leader two wide early the turn, found the rail late on the bend and could not rally. ESTRELLA ESMERAL tracked from well off the rail in the early going, angled in entering the turn and eventually found the rail, came back out exiting the bend and weakened. LIPSTICK LIES hesitated at the start and raced sluggishly in the early going, lagged behind on the inside and never got involved.

PACER took a stutter step out of the gate, stalked three then four deep on the first turn, raced up close to the outside of the leader up the backstretch, drew alongside ZAGREUS on the far turn, dueled into the lane, put a head in front at the top of the stretch, shifted out inside the eighth pole to bother a challenging FIX IT QUICK and stayed clear through the last sixteenth. FIX IT QUICK settled four then five wide on the clubhouse turn, followed in range three deep leaving the backstretch, remained three wide to the lane, challenged PACER from outside entering the final furlong but had his path taken and steadied, then kept on gamely to the secure second. ZAGREUS grabbed the early lead and moved inside, shifted to the two path around the clubhouse turn, was headed by TIGER STRENGTH approaching the backstretch, moved clear again, confronted by PACER on the far turn, dueled into the lane, lost command with a quarter mile left to run, fought to midstretch, then flattened in the late stages but finished a clear third. MILLBO BAGGINS stumbled at the start, stalked two then three wide, went two wide then found the rail late on the far turn and weakened in the drive. AUDIBLE SILENCE trailed three then two wide on the first turn and tugged the rider while racing keenly in hand, raced in range for most of the backstretch then lost ground into the far turn, rounded the second bend two then three wide and could not rally. TIGER STRENGTH showed speed from the rail but got put in tight and steadied into the first turn, rushed up leaving the backstretch, failed to match strides with the pacesetter but remained close to the far turn, dropped back around that bend, eased in the lane and walked off. THE RIDER ABOARD FIX IT QUICK LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST PACER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH. THE STEWARDS RULED, IN A MAJORITY DECISION, TO DISQUALIFY PACER FROM FIRST TO SECOND FOR SHIFTING OUT AND TAKING THE PATH OF FIX IT QUICK, COSTING THAT RIVAL A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.

SHE'S BACK chased between foes early, went two wide into the turn then moved inside, followed in range into the last furlong, dug in between late but got edged by the winner. DESPITE showed good early foot to take control, led two then three wide on the turn, remained clear under right then left handed urging into the final furlong, confronted by a pair of rivals at the sixteenth pole and yielded late. POLLY PUREBRED chased after the lone speed four deep, lost ground through the turn, came five wide into the stretch, drifted in down the lane and could not rally. COURTS DREAM was forced to take up early, dropped well off the pace, came three wide into the lane, altered a bit at the three-sixteenths pole and never threatened. SOUTHERN RIFF lacked early speed, saved ground to the stretch and never made an impact. SKY AT SUNRISE chased along the rail, fell back on the turn while moving to the two path and weakened in the drive. JUST MENDELSSOHN stumbled badly and unseated the rider leaving the gate, ran around at the back and was eventually corralled by the outrider and walked off.

SABINO CANYON pressed SOUTHERN MELODEE from outside early, three deep on the backstretch, came under a ride still three deep on the far turn, lost touch with START THE RIDE briefly midstretch, came back on with a furlong remaining and bested START THE RIDE in the last sixteenth. START THE RIDE stalked in the three path around the first turn, moved up inside the leader on the backstretch, put a head in front fighting with outer pair on the second bend, inched away briefly from SABINO CANYON midstretch, confronted by that rival again at the eighth pole and yielded grudgingly. FIONELLO got squeezed back early, reserved in the four path, followed in range two then three wide on the far turn, angled out approaching the stretch and finished willingly to earn the show honors. SOUTHERN MELODEE showed the way in the two path around the first turn with SABINO CANYON to the outside, joined by START THE RIDE up the inside on the backstretch, fought on even terms into the far turn, relinquished the lead to START THE RIDE, fought back around the bend, yielded in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. FUEGO DEL SOL stalked four wide on the first turn, continued wide in the middle stages, fell back to last while traveling three to four wide on the far turn and tired in the lane.
