OOBUBBAKAKAYO settled in the two path, closed in and challenged three deep midway around the far turn, led into the stretch, moved clear at the quarter pole, remained free into the final sixteenth and held over CATHAL (IRE) in the final strides. CATHAL (IRE) chased three then four wide around the turn from off the pace, traveled three wide on the far turn, angled out in upper stretch, came with a late run to draw alongside the winner but ran out of time. CAISSON broke a step slow, traveled two wide between rivals at the back early, moved into striking distance on the far turn, went three wide into the lane, closed willingly but lacked the needed late punch. GRANDISIMO bumped with inner rival at the start, angled in for the far turn, closed in on the second bend and showed late effort for a minor award. MONGOLIAN MAX got bumped between rivals at the start then crowded shortly after, tucked inside at the back, trailed through the far turn and improved position down the lane. BIG COUPE broke through the gate, ran off with the rider and eventually stopped late on the clubhouse turn, brough back and reloaded, was off alertly, dueled from inside into the first turn then dropped back a bit to give chase, moved to the two path at the five-sixteenths pole and weakened. DURAN bumped leaving the gate, sat off the pace two then three wide, moved into range while widest on the far turn, went five wide into the lane and tired. JIMMY BLUE JEANS bobbled leaving the gate, sent to duel into the first turn, cleared and crossed over, opened up a comfortable lead, got reeled in on the far turn and folded in the stretch.
