CLUBHOUSE BRIDE bobbled just slightly at the start, moved forward chasing the pace, took closer order leaving the turn, floated eight wide into upper stretch continuing to move out while making a bid nearing the furlong marker, drew clear, held. BROOKYS GAL settled off the pace, raced outside foes five wide on the turn, came out eleven wide by mid-stretch, was gaining too late. SMART MONIQUE was between foes off the pace four wide into the turn, dropped back and shifted in on that bend, rallied inside foes late. SHAMROCKIN settled inside foes off the fence, moved out turning for home, kicked on mildly seven to eight wide. HURRICANE LAYLA chased from off the rail inside the eventual winner on the turn, moved out turning for home, bid between foes seven wide past the three-sixteenths, evened out. MIRINDA was coaxed from the break and promptly shot well clear, set the pace, began weakening leaving the turn while coming into upper stretch well off the rail, was overtaken in upper stretch and gave way. MADIHA chased three to five wide and was never near enough to threaten. COIFFEUR chased from between foes well off the pace early, continued two to three wide, failed to menace. BIG SOIREE saved ground but was outpaced.
