SENSATIONAL Z Z sprinted to the front, met a bid at the seven-sixteenths pole, led in the four path turning for home, kicked clear in upper stretch, drew away into the final furlong and held safely late. RYAN'S GIRL stalked from inside into the turn, came three wide into the stretch, angled out further, finished well to gain second and closed the gap on the winner. LOVELY MEDAGLIA stalked in the two path leaving the backstretch, spun four wide into the lane and ran on for third. ROMAN EMPRESS brushed leaving the gate, bumped with a rival early, chased three deep between, had to take up into the turn, dropped back to last, summoned a mild rally and rounded out the superfecta. SHOP TILL YOU DROP bumped with ROMAN EMPRESS early, chased four deep leaving the backstretch, came five wide into the lane and churned on to the wire. HARNEY LANE broke in and brushed, trailed well off the rail, got forced out at the seven-sixteenths pole and could not rally. BAYTOWN BUTTERFLY got crowded early, angled to the inside, saved ground to the stretch and lacked a rally. DIAL A FRIEND stalked off the rail, bid outside at the seven-sixteenths pole, fought in the five path turning for home, got turned away in upper stretch, shifted out past the eighth pole and tired.
