CHARMED DREAM bumped leaving the gate then sped clear, crossed over to the inside, led a bit off the rail into the lane, continued with a comfortable lead into the final furlong and was kept busy to the wire. A KITTEN FOR SUE had to steady when losing a clear path at the nine-sixteenths pole, chased two wide between around the bend, rallied in the lane and got up for second. LOCHMARA forwardly placed four deep, moved into the three path around the bend, chased outside a rival turning for home, kept on down the lane and got edged for second. NINE FOOLS stalked from inside, angled three wide into the lane, finished evenly inside LOCHMARA and got outkicked for the place and show. DEVINE MARINA broke in and bumped, saved ground to the stretch and failed to threaten. RUMPUS A. P. was fractious in the gate, in range two wide into the turn, lost ground two to three wide on the turn and weakened. C'MON LETS SWITCH broke in and bumped, was rank chasing out wide on the backstretch, went five wide into the lane and drifted inward while weakening. LADY LITHEsome broke a step slow and got bumped back, raced six wide on the turn and was never a factor. BREVILLE brushed leaving the gate, stalked three deep between rivals, went four deep into the drive and faded. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate final time available.
