CARDBOARD TOMMY took control early then got pressured from inside by TIGHT DALLY, cleared that rival around the bend, remained unchallenged into the final sixteenth, came under threat from a pair of rivals late but was able to hold. HUNGOVER raced in mid-pack off the rail, went two wide into the turn, between rivals at the three-eighths pole, chased three wide into the stretch, closed in through the lane, reeled in CARDBOARD TOMMY late but ran out of ground. STILL BULLETPROOF got bumped on both sides at the dispatch, sat off the pace outside a rival, angled widest into the lane, came with a late run, drew alongside the top pair and missed second. TIGHT DALLY pressed from inside, lost contact and steered off the rail chasing after the leader, exited the bend in the three path and weakened. I B SALTY was off slow to begin, sat off the pace staying away from the rail, took the turn four then five wide and

flattened out in the lane. KIKI RIDE was forwardly placed from outside, went two wide into the turn, spun four wide off the turn and weakened down the lane. SMOKEM AND LOVE tracked from inside out of range, eased off the fence around the bend, came three wide into the drive and failed to rally. TONY'S FEVER bumped at the start, sat off the pace on the inside, angled four wide around the bend and failed to menace. TIGER TO YOU stalked from inside, fell out of range on the turn while moving into the two path, then weakened in the drive. AMERICANO W'CHROME broke in and bumped, trailed off the rail, took the turn three wide and was never a factor. BUCKY'S BOY followed in range in the early going, took the turn three then four wide and faded.
