IMELDA IS MY LIGHT was closest in pursuit form off the rail, went two wide into the turn, took aim three to four wide turning for home, reeled in the leader midstretch and put a head in front at the eighth pole, cleared briefly, drifted in while coming under threat from A P OXBOW with a sixteenth remaining and held gamely. A P OXBOW stumbled leaving the gate, got crowded early, lacked room on the turn racing on the inside, gained an opening at the five-sixteenths pole, rallied from inside in deep stretch but could not get by the winner. INCA bobbled a bit at the start, sped clear and crossed over, showed the way three wide into the lane, got run down entering the final furlong and weakened in the last sixteenth. OSCAR STORM bobbled at the start, trailed off the rail, passed a rival in the three path into the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. PUB CHEESE BOB chased three deep, rounded the turn three then four wide and weakened. CROSS FEVER broke a step slow, tracked from inside out of range, moved to the two path on the turn and came up empty in the drive. R PRADA broke well, chased two wide into the turn, dropped back around the bend, eased in the lane and walked off.
